Maths

We will count forwards and backwards from any number within 10 and identify one more and one less. We will continue to practise recognising the numerals, and work on our counting with one to one correspondence. We will begin to subitise- recognising what a number is without counting (for example 5 dots on a dice) and start to recall number bonds to 5.

Physical Development

Mr Flynn will teach PE on a Tuesday morning where the children will focus on following instructions and moving their bodies to warm up for exercise and cool down afterwards.

We will continue to take part in 3 x weekly sessions of Funky Fingers and Dough Disco. We will also focus on the use of scissors as we have noticed this is a skill that the children require some support with.

Reminders

Please make sure your child brings in their water bottle and book bag each day and they are emptied out each night.

If your child has borrowed any items of school clothing please could you return them so we can use them for other children if needed.

Please make sure your child brings a coat into school daily as the weather is getting more unpredictable as we go outside every day. They may bring **ONE healthy** fruit snack in their book bag or they can have a piece of free fruit on offer in school.

Phonics and Communication and Language

We will continue our strong emphasis on speaking and listening both with adults and our peers. We will also work on the correct pencil grip to write our names.

We will continue phase 2 phonics and the children will develop their blending and segmenting skills with words using learnt sounds. They will also learn the first sets of Tricky and High Frequency Words.

Please hear your child read three times a week to support them.

PSHE and RE

Our topics will be 'Keeping Myself Safe' and Antibullying. We will discuss the importance of keeping our bodies safe and looking out for ourselves and others.

This half term our topic will be 'Celebrating' where we will discuss the Christian celebration Christmas and Jesus' birthday.

Maths: Y1 We will count reliably in 2's to 20 and 10's to 100. We will count, read and order numbers 0-50 and 50-0. We look at addition and subtraction using objects and pictures and sharing objects equally by counting how many in each group

English and Phonics:

Y1 We will begin phase 5 phonics learning to distinguish between the alternative spelling of the same sound eg ai/ay, ow/ou, We will continue to write simple and compound sentences by planning what we are going to write, forming letters correctly and of the correct size. We will leave spaces between words and end with a full stop. We will look at simple past tense words adding ed where no change to the root word is needed.

Reminders

Children should access Numbots and Bug Club at least three times a week at home.

PE will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays for Y1 and they can come to school dressed in their kit.
