We ask all our children to wear school uniform. The school colours are royal blue and grey. Sweatshirts, polo-shirts and T-shirts, bearing our school logo, can be purchased online via two suppliers. Please order early to ensure delivery before September.

It is acceptable for children to wear non monogrammed (plain) uniform, eg. plain white polo shirt. This can be purchased via any uniform provider.

The school association (Friends of Owslebury) regularly holds second-hand uniform sales and PPG funding is used to purchase uniform for children when required, on a case by case basis. #### ALL UNIFORM MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

Winter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Grey skirt or pinafore dress or trousers.</li><li>• White monogrammed Owslebury polo shirt.*</li><li>• Blue monogrammed Owslebury sweatshirt or cardigan.*</li><li>• Black, or grey tights.</li><li>• Plain blue, black, white or grey socks.</li></ul>
Summer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Light blue checked dress</li><li>• Grey shorts.</li><li>• White monogrammed Owslebury polo shirt.*</li><li>• Plain blue, black, white or grey socks.</li></ul>
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shoes should be sensible – buckled, laced or Velcro-fastened, and black.</li><li>• Trainer-type shoes are only acceptable in black.</li><li>• White/black trainers are only acceptable for PE/games.</li><li>• Summer shoes/sandals should be sturdy, safe, and suitable for playtime activities.</li></ul>
Games/PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Black shorts.</li><li>• Black tracksuit bottoms.</li><li>• Royal Blue T-shirt.</li><li>• Black or white plimsolls or white trainers.</li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The above items should be kept in a NAMED PE drawstring bag. (Yr R only)</li> </ul>
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children should not wear any jewellery such as rings or necklaces for health and safety reasons.</li> <li>• If a child has their ear pierced, they may wear a stud earring only, which should be covered with tape for PE.</li> <li>• Long hair (below shoulder length) should be tied back.</li> <li>• Hair accessories (hair bands, bows, ribbons, and hair clips etc.) should be kept small and, if possible, in school colours (blue or black).</li> <li>• Hair should be a natural colour.</li> <li>• Hair varnish or any make up is not permitted.</li> </ul>
Outdoor Education	<p>If the children have any planned Forest School activities, parents are informed when these sessions will take place and must ensure that appropriate clothing for wet and muddy conditions is brought in – ie:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wellies/walking boots and thick socks.</li> <li>• Waterproof jacket/kagoul.</li> <li>• Old jeans and sweatshirt or overalls – leggings are NOT appropriate as they are too thin.</li> <li>• Waterproof trousers</li> </ul>

*The school welcomes children from all backgrounds and faith communities. If there are serious reasons, for example on religious grounds, why parents want their child to wear clothes that differ from the school uniform (class and PE), the Uniform Policy will consider such requests sympathetically. If any parent would like to request an exception to the uniform policy they should, in the first instance, contact the headteacher and then the Governors*
