Welcome to Marwell Class. We share these 'Learning Forecasts' every half term to give an insight into the key areas that we will focus on with your child.

Phonics

We will start with Phase 1 Letters and Sounds listening to sounds around us and then in a few weeks begin Phase 2 where we will teach a new sound each day. We will update you on Tapestry when this will start and share what you can do to support your child.

We will also sing nursery rhymes each day and play listening games.



Maths

We will sing counting songs and recognise and order numbers to 10 and beyond. We will also count objects in lots of practical activities such as the number of children in class.

Communication and Language

We will practice sitting still and focusing on an activity as a class including Phonics or storytime. We will share ideas and listen to others.

We will spend time helping the children to settle into to our new rules and routines and get to know their class. They will form new friendships with adults and children and learn how to negotiate with others
