English

This term's English focus is mostly linked to our Stone Age topic, focusing on 'Stone Age Boy' as our main reading and writing text.

Children will continue to become secure in non-negotiables in writing such as consistency with capital letters and full stops, as well as developing fluent, joined handwriting. Some children will be working towards their pen license.

Science

Our science learning this term is all about 'Rocks & Soils'. They will explore the different types of rocks and how they are formed and will be completing investigations into the permeability of rocks and soils.

Maths

For maths, we will be continuing to secure our understanding about Shape, lines, turns and angles. We will also be learning about Statistics, Money and Decimals.

Reading

We will mainly be focusing our reading and comprehension skills around the classic text 'Stig of the Dump'.

The children will work on their inference skills, making predictions and familiarisations with characters from the story.

PE

We will have PE on a Monday and a Wednesday. The children will be focusing on athletics and cricket this half term.

History

Our overall topic is 'Stone Age to Iron Age'. The children will be learning about historical eras ranging from the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. We will focus on how Early Man lived and look at geographical settlements. We will celebrate this topic with our Stone Age camp.

RE

Children will be looking at the concept of Symbol in Christianity. The children will learn about the difference between signs and symbols and how symbols are used to represent ideas in the Christian religion.
