English

The children will write:

- A persuasive advert for a toy
- A description based on 'Toys in Space'
- A story based on 'That rabbit belongs to Emily Brown'

Y1 Use capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, phonics, the correct letter formation and using 'and' to write simple sentences.

Y2 Spelling common exception words, using conjunctions and contractions, adding suffixes to root words and proof reading to write longer pieces of writing.

Children should be reading at least 5x per week and record into their reading record.

Maths

Y1 Place value, addition and subtraction, measurement: time and mass, fractions and geometry.

Y2 Place value and addition and subtraction, statistics, measurement: mass and time, fractions and geometry.

Children should access Numbots at least 3 times

Reminders

Children to bring book bags and water bottles in to school daily.

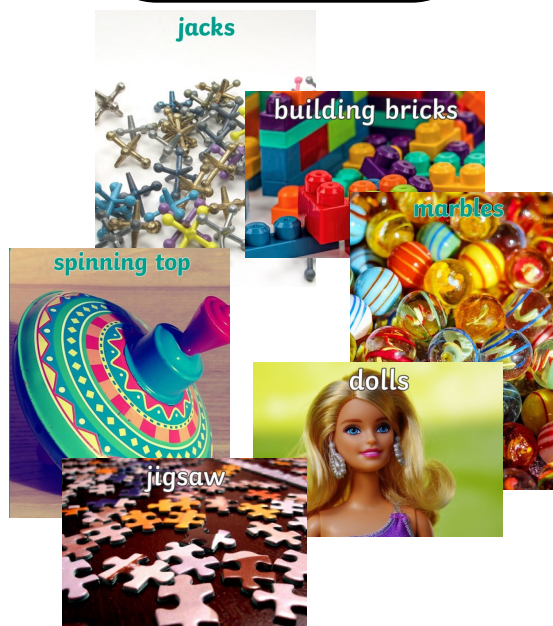
