English

The children will write a story and a diary.

Y1 Sitting at a table properly, holding a pencil comfortably to correctly form lower case and capital letters. Write sentences by saying out loud what they are going to write, leave spaces between words, start with a capital letter, end with a full stop and re read the sentence.

Y2 Write sentences by planning what they are going to write, forming letters correctly and of the correct size, leave spaces between words, end with . ? or ! and proof read to add revisions and corrections. Children will be using noun phrases to make their writing interesting.
